ADVANCE WORKSHEET FOR LIVESTOCK - AGRISTABILITY OPTION - REQUEST FOR INCREASED ADVANCE

This Advance Worksheet may be used by Producers seeking an increased Advance on Livestock, where the Advance is secured by AgriStability.

A. LIVESTOCK ADVANCE

In this Worksheet, Western Cash Advance Program Inc. is referred to as either 'WeCAP" or the "Administrator". Other APP administrators are referred to as "other Administrators".

This Advance Worksheet may be used by Livestock Producers who wish to secure their Advance with an assignment of their AgriStability benefits. This Assignment, and documentation concerning the Producer's AgriStability enrollment indicated below, must be submitted with the Application. Advance is not limited by the security; however, Producers must always maintain the security coverage until the APP Advance has been fully repaid.

The Producer must not have more than one million (\$1,000,000) outstanding in Advances, including as a result of the overlap between Program Years. Advances amounts issued above the first two hundred fifty thousand (\$250,000) issued in the Program Year shall be interest-bearing and will be limited by other interest-free amounts issued to the producer and/or Related Producers. Advance amounts issued above the first two hundred fifty thousand (\$250,000) issued in a Program Year shall be interest-bearing.

For Continuous Flow Operations, only one twelve (12) month Continuous Flow Operation Advance Cycle is allowed per Program Year.

Producers must submit their Statement of Inventory worksheet, 2023 AgriStability Program Enrollment/Fee Notice and Proof of Payment, AgriStability Production Margin summary, including schedules 2&3 for 2020 and 2021.

Livestock must already be born to be eligible for an advance. Advances will only be issued on Livestock that the Producer expects to be marketed by the end of the Production Period.
